Friday night from 22.00 till 24.00 hours the bar in the mill will be open for those who don't want to go home just yet and want to relax for a while.

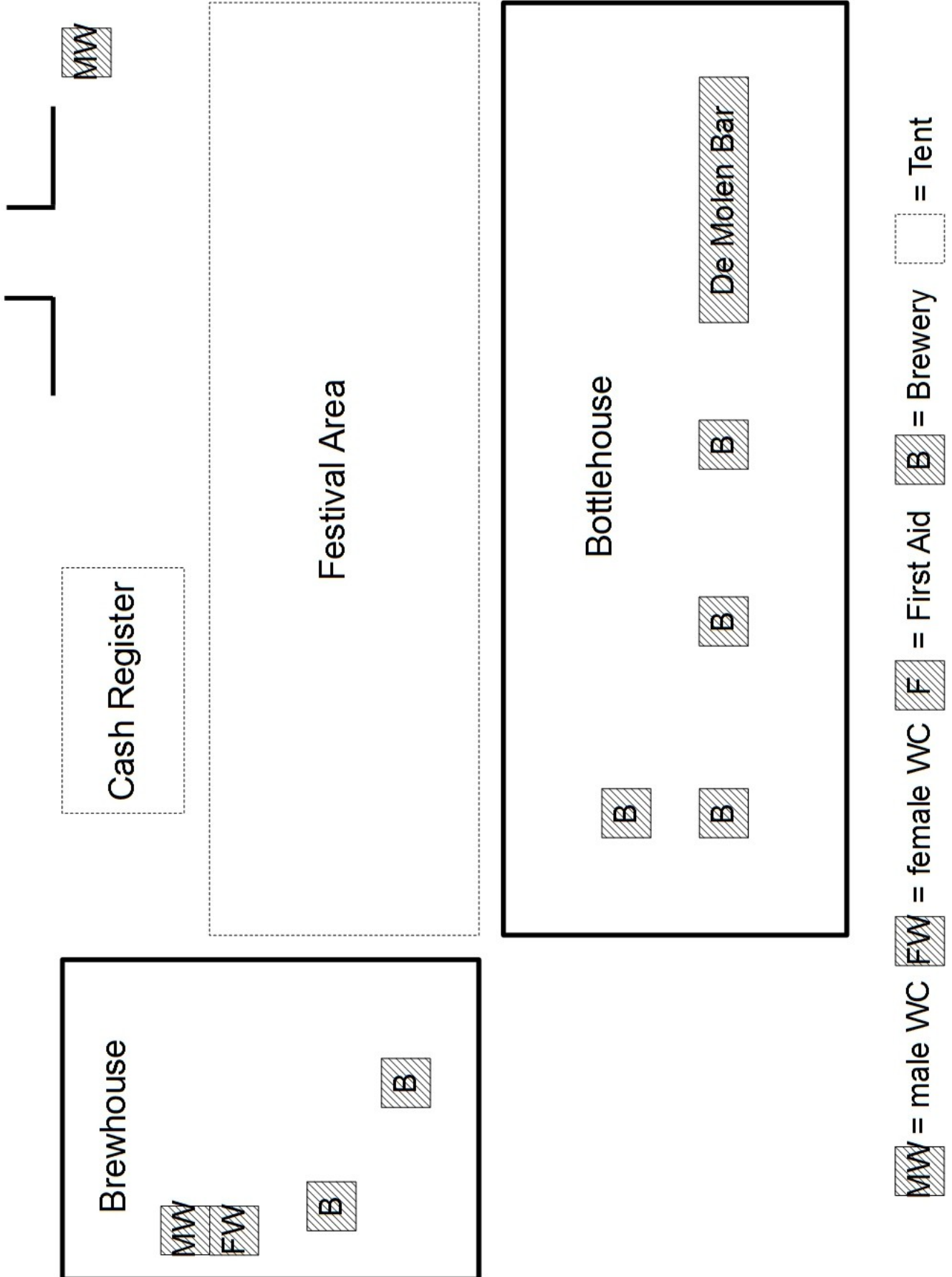
## **Train information**

Every 15 minutes past the hour and every 15 minutes to the hour. For example: 16:15, 16:45, 17:15 and 21:45 until 00:45.

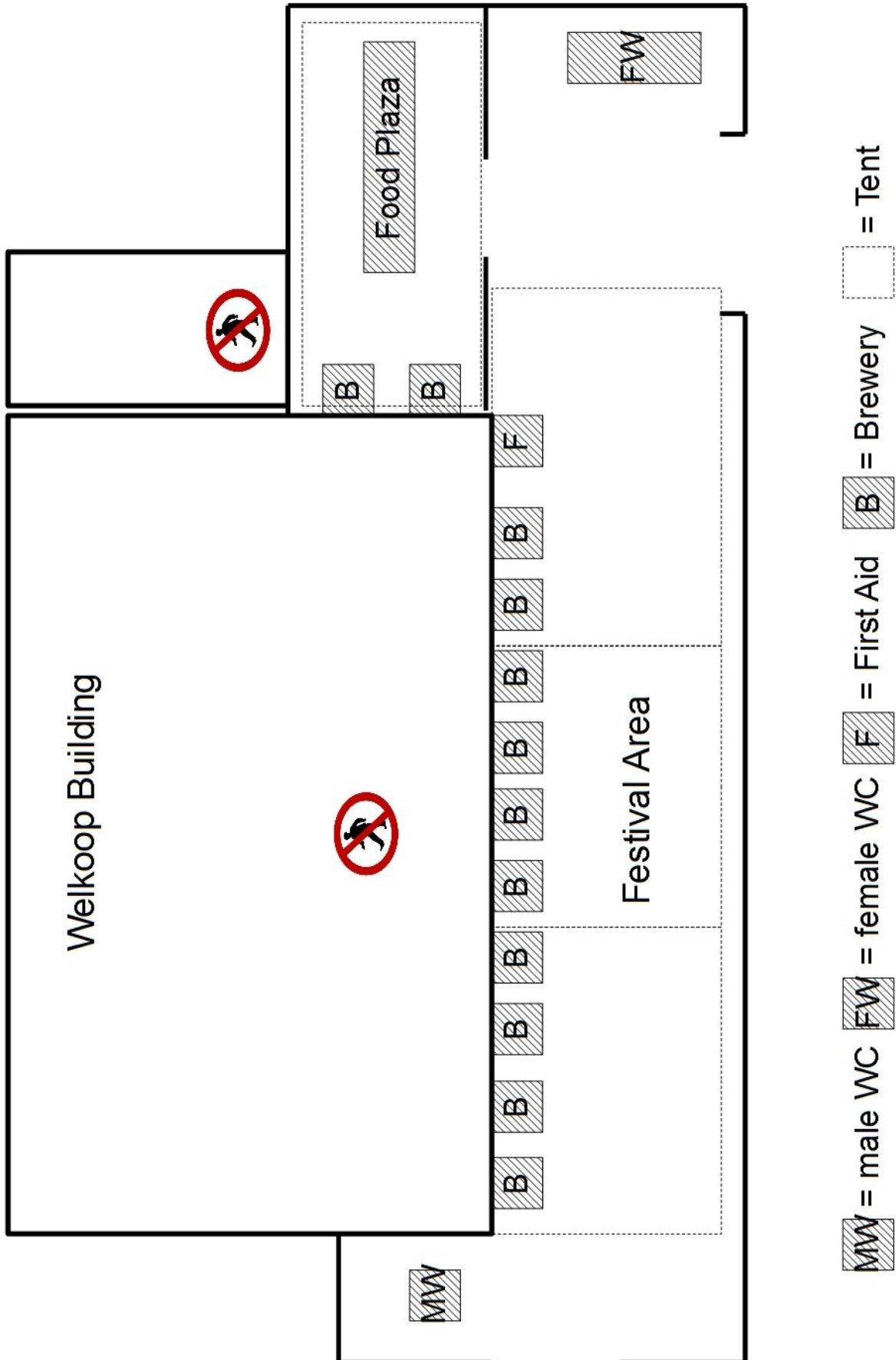
# Floor Plan of the Brewery (Doortocht 4)
